Enrollment is open from October 1 – March 1. The deadline to add projects is July 1.

4-H AGES for the 2023-2024 4-H Year

^{*}Grade as of January 1 of the current 4-H year (October-October). Accordingly, youth participate in summer and fall fair activities in the grade they just completed. These are standard grades based on public school general ages. Exceptions such as home or private schools or youth who have skipped a grade must be determined under the appropriate age.

Active Membership

Curry County 4-H members must maintain an "Active Membership" status prior to participation in 4-H Rodeo, County Contests, District and State Conference, or Junior Divisions of the Curry County Fair. An "active" member will be considered one who completes enrollment prior to March 1, attends four (4) or more regularly scheduled 4-H meetings. No more than two (2) meetings in any given month will count toward the membership requirement. Meetings count during the 4-H year which is October 1st through September 30th.

County 4-H Shooting Sports Safety Training

A yearly safety meeting is **REQUIRED** for all 4-H shooting sports members. Youth cannot participate in live fire (in any discipline) until they complete a safety meeting for the 23/24 4-H year and complete enrollment. There will be a safety meeting on **Tuesday November 28**th at **6 pm** at the new Extension Building. Youth must attend with an adult. If you are an adult interested in becoming certified to coach 4-H shooting sports, please contact the Extension Office.

Curry County 4-H Ride Nights



Our County Horse Leader will be hosting ride nights at the Mounted Patrol Arena (Outdoor Arena on the Fairgrounds) on November 17 @ 3 pm & December 1 @ 2:30pm. Members must be currently enrolled in Curry County 4-H and a 4-H Horse Project. Additional siblings and adults are ride at your own risk (youth must be accompanied by an adult). Any rider deemed unsafe will be removed from the arena. Please contact the Extension Office for more information.

2023-2024 Enrollment

If you were a member of Curry County 4-H last year, you have a ZSuites account. It is under the primary email you used to enroll. Each family is created under a Household, so you can update all youth and volunteers in one account. Deadline for youth enrollment is March 1, however if youth want to attend events/workshops, they will need to complete enrollment asap. Visit https://4h.zsuite.org/

You will log in with your email and select reset password. Verify that contact information is correct, update clubs and projects, then submit enrollment for each individual. Provide a signed copy of the liability and medical release form to the Extension Office to complete enrollment. Enrollment will be pending until all documentation is received in the Extension Office.
